Thoda's Embedded Alternates

Inside the Choda fonts there are some alternate characters that can be used in lieu of the regular ones. There are two common methods of activating Choda's alternates in Windows applications: one is to use the Character Map accessory that comes with Windows to copy the desired alternate and paste it into the application, and the other, handier and more commonly used method, is to use the keyboard's NAT key with various numerical comibnations to obtain the alternates. Below is a little table showing the included alternates in the Choda fonts and the key combinations that can produce them.
